

Vehicle Accident Form

What to do if you are in a car accident with a rental or Acadia-owned vehicle:

- 1. Call the police if there are injuries, if the damage to either vehicle exceeds \$1,000 in Ontario and New Brunswick, and \$2,000 in Nova Scotia, Newfoundland and Labrador. Always call the police in the case of a hit and run.
- 2. Do not make any statements admitting fault.
- 3. Gather contact details of other drivers, passengers, and any witnesses.
- 4. Take photos of the scene, driver's licence, licence plate and registration card from anyone involved.
- 5. If your vehicle is not drivable, have it towed to a body shop.
- 6. Submit the Vehicle Accident Form by email to security.office@acadiau.ca and Risk Management. All vehicle accidents in Acadia owned or rental vehicles must be reported to Campus Security.
- 7. An Occurrence Report must also be submitted with Safety and Security as soon as possible. This can be done in person or by phone (902-585-1103) if you are away from Acadia University campus. - 8. If Acadia University research assistants were injured, they may also be required to complete a WCB injury report. They should reach out to their supervisor to request assistance in filling out the report found at www.wcb.ns.ca. See Claims, Forms for Workers, WCB Injury Report.
